Features

R = Red Week/B = Blue Week

In elementary school the red and blue weeks signify the special classes held in that given week.

The superscript numbers ^{1 2 3 4} indicate days one, two, three and four. Day 1 is for block periods A, B, C & D and day 2 is for block periods E, F, G and H, day 3 is for block periods, D, B,C and A and day 4 is for block periods H, F, G and E for middle and high schools.

- School holidays are in **bold and shaded in blue.**
- Faculty workdays/in-service days are shaded diagonally in **red.**
- Late start Fridays are shaded **light blue.**
- Early release days have a **red cell border.**
- Non-observed holidays and/or special days are underlined.
- **School begins on Monday, August 17th for Middle and High School.**
- **School begins Tuesday, August 18th for Elementary School.**
- There is an attempt to provide one three-day weekend (or more) per month for families, and often for faculty, to de-stress the environment.
- HS Graduation is on **June 6.**
- Parent Conference days are scheduled on the **13th of November and the 5th of March** for all schools.

CONDITIONS

1. All applications for new students and re-registrations for returning students must be accompanied by payment of 10,000 NIS deposit per student, which will be deducted from the tuition invoice.
2. If a student is not accepted to the school the full deposit of 10,000 NIS will be refunded. If a student is accepted and chooses not to enroll 6,500 NIS will be refunded.
3. Tuition and transportation fees must be paid in advance on an annual basis by **August 31, 2009.**
4. **Please note that by School Board policy, in no case may a student remain in school if full tuition payments are not received within 45 days of their due date.**
5. Payment is accepted in Dollar checks and Shekel checks. US\$ amounts paid in Shekels should be converted at the representative rate of the US\$ on the date of payment. Shekel amounts that are paid in US\$ should be converted at the representative US\$ rate on the date of payment. **NO FOREIGN CURRENCY (INCLUDING US\$) IN CASH** will be accepted.
6. **Late Fee:** Tuition fees received after the completion of the 45th day of attendance are considered late and the outstanding balance is subject to a simple interest late penalty with a rate established by the School Board in the June meeting prior to the following academic year. Exceptions to this may be brought in front of the Superintendent for consideration.
7. In case of early withdrawal or late entrance of a student, School Board policy will apply.
